

# Top Ten for 2020

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In 2020, the Washington Poison Center (WAPC) handled 138, 528 phone calls and managed 67,504 cases, over 378 calls and 184 cases per day.

There were 55,623 human poison exposures, with children five and younger accounting for 43% of all poison exposure cases. Human exposures with more serious outcomes (moderate, major, or death) accounted for 8.23% of all exposures. There were 11,731 information cases. Slightly more than 57% of cases regarding children under 6 were for non-medications.

While 82% of poisonings were unintentional; nearly 18% were intentional, with suicidal intent suspected in 12% of these cases. Of the 8556 medication errors,13% were in children under 6 years old and over 30% were in adults 60 years and older.
