- Winners announced: Wednesday, March 10, 2021

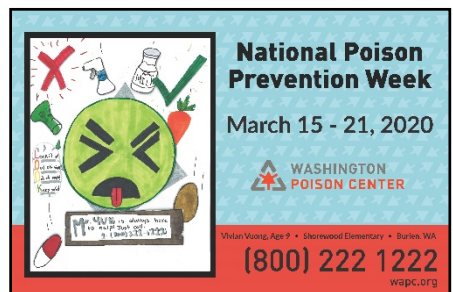
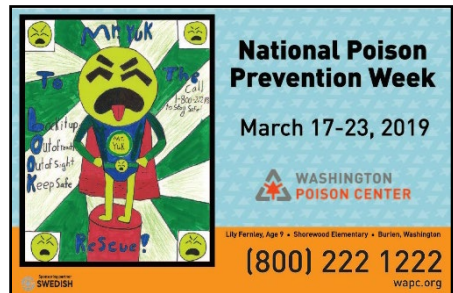
The Winners Receive
