### The Winner will receive:

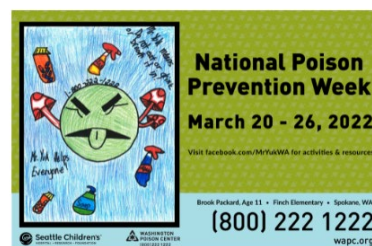
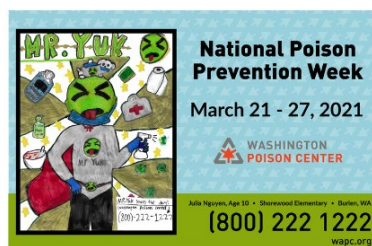
- A Samsung Galaxy Tablet
