- **Data, research, and advocacy:** real-time monitoring of poisoning trends and expert support for public health leaders, clinicians, and policymakers

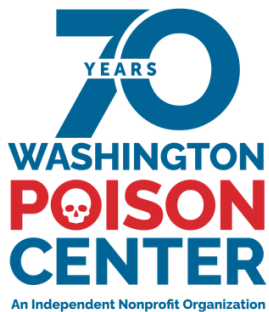

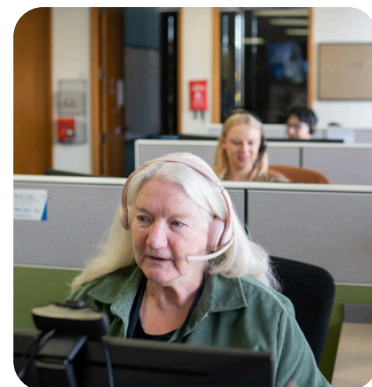

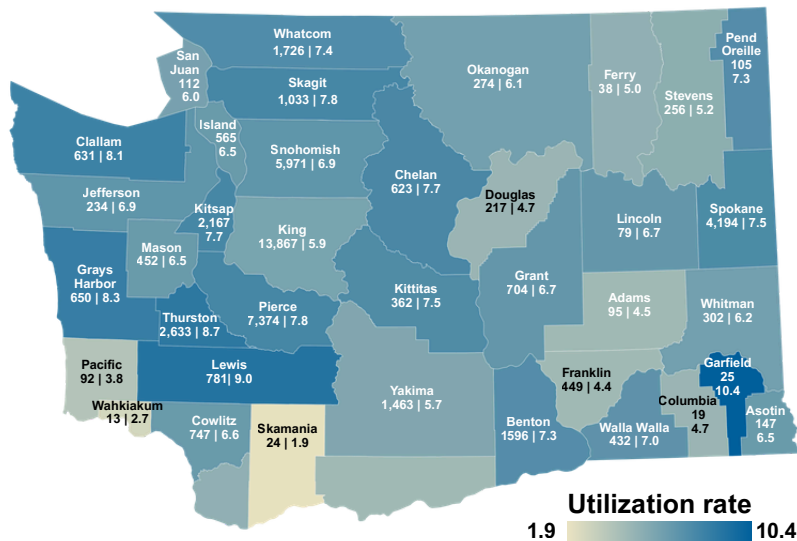
